
Conceptual Architecture



Main Benefits

- Service Providers: Efficient use of limited resources
- End Users: Access to important data through multiple platforms/ devices and a consistent, intuitive environment









Service Providers

- Concentrate on providing and maintaining service Content!
- Providers do not have to use their limited resources learning each new platform, browser, programming language that is required for providing data on various platforms
- Providers do not have to learn prevailing display standards and guidelines for each platform.
- Services provided in a platform-independent manner can be presented to users on multiple platforms with little or no additional work from the service provider.
- Reduced support contacts as users are not affected by backend changes and system upgrades.




End Users

- Ability to access information on numerous platforms. This allows the user to select what is most convenient for them at a given time under various circumstances.
- Experience a consistent look and feel throughout a given platform (portal, web, iPhone, etc.), regardless of what service provider the data is coming from. The user remains in a single environment with a single navigational structure which leads to:
 - Increased ease of use
 - Reduced learning curve
 - Eliminates the distraction and reduced efficiency that results from interface and navigational differences.
- The end user is not affected by backend changes and system upgrades
